### **Advocacy Groups to Rally Thursday Morning in Boston Before Hearing on NRC Post-Fukushima Orders**

**WHO:** Pilgrim Coalition, Clean Water Action and other environmental advocacy groups concerned that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is not making nuclear power plants safe enough in light of lessons learned from Fukushima.

**WHAT:** The environmental and safety groups will rally outside the McCormack Courthouse before the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board is scheduled to hear oral arguments regarding two NRC post-Fukushima orders. The hearing begins at 10 a.m. in Court Room 1, 12th Floor and was requested by Duxbury-based Pilgrim Watch, a member of the Pilgrim Coalition. The coalition opposed the relicensing application for Entergy's Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station in Plymouth, Mass., which was approved May 25, 2012.
