Re: Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station: Chapter 91 Request for Enforcement Against
Entergy Nuclear Regarding Mooring System on Jetty

Dear Shaun,

This is to follow up on our September 16, 2015 email sending you pictures of Entergy's unlawful mooring system on public tidelands. We discussed this after the adjudicatory hearing on September 24, 2015 and you indicated that MassDEP would be looking in to it. We have not heard anything since about whether MassDEP will take enforcement action regarding Entergy's unlawful actions.

Entergy's installation of the pulley system on the jetty was a clear end run around the administrative appeal of the land based system and an intentional effort to evade regulation. Entergy has taken advantage of the system and the MassDEP adjudicatory hearing process.

As you may recall, Entergy's engineer, Philip Harizi admitted that the system was installed on the jetty so there is no question as to the facts. In addition, the system is described in Entergy's application to the Plymouth Conservation Commission.

We request a response to our inquiry explaining what MassDEP will do about this intentional, clear cut violation.
